

**REDKEN 2012 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Redken is pleased to announce an exciting new scholarship opportunity for current and prospective cosmetology students of The Salon Professional Academy franchise locations.

## APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please read entire application before completing this application.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. You must be a high school graduate or have a General Equivalency Diploma (GED).
2. Cosmetology students must be currently enrolled in or have been accepted to a franchise location of The Salon Professional Academy/APS, LLC. You can not be enrolled in another school offering a similar course of study at the time of awarding or disbursement.
3. Current student applicants must have at the time of application and must maintain 85% grades and 90% attendance at the awarding checkpoints to be eligible. For prospective students, a minimum 90% GPA needs to be indicated on your high school transcript and must be maintaining an 85% grades and 90% attendance at the time of disbursement. Winning students must be enrolled in, or graduated from, a participating franchise location of The Salon Professional Academy.
4. Family members of Redken, The Salon Professional Academy and APS, LLC are not eligible for scholarships.

## SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

1. Applications will be reviewed by the Redken Scholarship Advisory Board; all decisions are final. Applications will be submitted by The Academy Admissions Representative to Darci Ludwig, Redken Director, School Development, for review by the Scholarship Advisory Board.
2. Forty-eight scholarships will be awarded in total. Each of the twenty-four franchise locations (as of 1-1-12) are eligible for \$1000 for the top written application AND one \$500 scholarship for the top video application. If no eligible applications are submitted, the scholarship will be void.
3. Winners will be notified by phone or mail on or by April 30.
4. Scholarships will be awarded based on letters of recommendation, quality of essay responses as well the overall quality of the complete application.
5. Scholarship money will be disbursed in (2) installments: The first disbursement will take place at the 900-hour mark; the second will be released at the midway point in the second Academic Year. Student must be at 85% grades and 90% attendance at these checkpoints to qualify for the disbursement. If the recipient is disqualified, no alternative awards will be provided.
6. Each scholarship award will be applied towards tuition, fees and books needed to complete the student's training, and will be submitted directly payable to The Salon Professional Academy on your behalf. Scholarship is not transferable as cash.
7. Personal phone conference interviews will be arranged for eligible students when the committee finds it necessary to break a tie or make a final decision.
8. Essays will be rated based on the following system:
  - 10% professionalism of the response
  - 20% dedication to the salon professional industry
  - 70% articulation of thought in the fewest number of words
9. All documentation from applicants will be kept on file, regardless of scholarship acceptance.

## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

### APPLICATION DETAILS

1. Application information must be completed in its entirety to be considered for a scholarship.
2. Applicant must provide two letters of recommendation. Your references should be from employers, educators, counselors, or someone qualified to offer testimony of your character. These references should not be people who are related to you. The reference's role is to write a letter of recommendation supporting your candidacy.
3. All essay questions should be answered on an attached typed document to be eligible for the \$1000 written scholarship award. To be eligible for a \$500 scholarship, all essay questions should be video recorded and submitted via CD-ROM.
4. Please include a high school transcript or GED equivalent as proof of graduation, showing 90% grades and 90% attendance with school seal imprinted and/or the signature of a school official. If you are a current TSPA student, please submit a copy of your TSPA transcript with an approved signature, showing 85% grades and 90% attendance.
5. Application must be postmarked by March 23, 2012 to be considered for one of the 2012 scholarships.
6. Redken Scholarship Advisory Board will select scholarship recipients based on the criteria listed on this application.
7. Applications should be sent to the Admissions Representative at the TSPA location where you would apply the scholarship if awarded.
