3. Submit the above listed items along with your most recent high school **transcript** to The Academy by the deadline for review by the scholarship committee.

Deadline: April 30, 2012

The 2012 Top Self Scholarship is based on the student’s goals regarding the beauty industry. The committee will also take a close look at the student’s personal references in determining the student’s character and integrity. This scholarship will give the student **\$3000** off their tuition. While at the Academy, the student must maintain an 85% or above grade point average and 85% or higher attendance at all times and must not have any suspensions.

All scholarships are awarded for the July 16, 2012 full time Cosmetology course.
